Pastor's Message

Dear St. Mark's,

Alleluia! Christ is risen indeed! As the Easter season continues and spring unfolds in full bloom, May brings with it many occasions to celebrate the gift of family and community. With Mother's Day just around the corner and graduations on the horizon, it's a fitting time to reflect on the Fourth Commandment:

"Honor your father and your mother." (Exodus 20:12)

When we first read this commandment, many of us understand it as if it only speaks to our relationships with our parents. But Luther's understanding in the Small Catechism reminds us that this commandment is also about honoring *all* those who have been placed in our lives as caregivers, mentors, and guides, especially those who nurture us, teach us, and shape us.

Some of us have had wonderful relationships with our parents. Others may carry pain, loss, or distance in those relationships. Still, the call to "honor" invites us to recognize the people that God has placed in our lives. This might be a parent, grandparent, foster parent, or guardian. It might also be a teacher, a coach, a neighbor, or an elder in the church who took time to listen, to encourage, and to guide you.

To honor someone is to treat them with respect and gratitude, not because they are perfect, but because God has worked through them in our lives. And in turn, we are called to be people who offer that same love and care to others.

As we celebrate Mother's Day this month, let us expand our vision of who we honor and how we give thanks. Let us remember and uplift those who have shaped us, and let us seek to be mentors and spiritual parents to others. In Christ, we are all called to be part of God's family.

May God continue to bless you this spring with moments of reflection, gratitude, and joy.
