Dear St. Mark's Lutheran,

July offers us moments to reconnect with nature, with family, and with God. This month, we reflect on the **Sixth Commandment: "You shall not commit adultery"**. This is a call not only to marital fidelity but to a deeper sense of faithfulness in all our relationships.

In *The Small Catechism*, Martin Luther writes, "We should fear and love God, so that we lead a chaste and decent life in word and deed, and that husband and wife each love and honor the other." For us today, this commandment is both about what happens in a marriage and more. It's about honoring the commitments we make, nurturing trust, and treating others, including ourselves, with dignity and respect.


